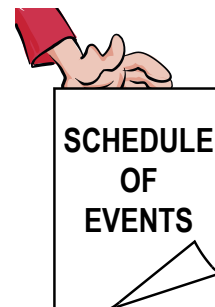


SCHEDULE OF EVENTS: SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 2007
